NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following measure is to be submitted to the qualified electors of the City of Pacifica to be voted on at the Special Consolidated Municipal Election to be held in the City of Pacifica, on Tuesday, May 19, 2009.

WHEREAS, a measure will be submitted as follows:

Pacifica Vital City Services Protection Measure. To preserve public safety; prevent cuts to essential City services, including police, fire, 9-1-1 emergency response, street and pothole repair, and youth recreation programs; improve traffic flow and safety; protect local coastal areas and beaches from polluted runoff and trash; and provide other general fund services, shall Pacifica adopt a one-cent sales tax expiring in 2016, subject to financial audits, public expenditure reports, and a Citizen's Oversight Committee?



NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that March 20, 2009 at 12:00 noon is hereby fixed as the final date on which rebuttal arguments, not exceeding 250 words in length may be submitted to the City Clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as required by law.

All arguments shall be accompanied by a statement, to be signed by each proponent and by each author of the argument, if different, stating that such argument is true and correct to the best of their knowledge and belief. No more than five signatures shall appear on the ballot with any argument.

The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
