Morning Drop-Off:

Adventure Camp is happy to offer Express Drop-Off for our busy camp families-on-the-go. Drop-Off is available from 8:00-8:45AM Monday-Friday. For Regular Drop-Off, please park your vehicle along Oddstad Blvd. and walk your camper to the Drop-Off ramp/tables.

Afternoon Pick-Up:

Adventure Camp pick-up is between 3:45-4:00PM and we ask that you please walk to the Adventure Camp entrance to sign them out. **Please bring a photo ID card with you.** Campers will not be released to unauthorized individuals. To modify your pick-up authorization persons, please see the Adventure Camp Site Supervisor to update your form. **Late Pick Up:** If you camper is not picked up by 4:00PM (regular day) or 6:00PM (After Camp Program), you will be charged a late fee of \$1 per minute per child. All fees will be collected at time of pick up. Cash or check are only accepted.

Express Drop-off – 8:00-8:45AM*:

Adventure Camp is happy to offer Express Drop-Off for our busy camp families-on-the-go. Express Drop-Off is available daily. **On Wednesdays, Express Drop off will end at 8:30AM so that campers may board our buses on time.** Due to the nature of drop-off for our families, the safety of our camp staff and campers, and the consideration of other patrons who use our facility, we ask that you please follow the below guidelines when using Express Drop-Off.

- Please observe and follow directions from all recreation staff
- Please follow the map for Express Drop-Off. Drivers not using the pre-determined route will not be eligible for Express Drop-Off.
- Please do not use Express Drop-Off if your camper is not ready for camp. We cannot accommodate campers who many need assistance or who are missing camp items. Please utilize the parking spots along Oddstad Blvd if you sense your camper may need additional attention and walk into the camp site.
- Pull as far forward as possible when reaching the curb to accommodate other vehicles.
- Please be alert of pedestrians.
- Please respect merging vehicles at both the lower and upper parking lot entrance/exit.
