Captain Clements provided the following comments;

On April 26th PG&E hosted a Public Safety Liaison event in San Carlos.

On April 27th Captain Spanheimer facilitated an EOC exercise at the Pacifica Police Department which was attended by department staff throughout the City. The scenario consisted of a traffic collision involving a truck tractor, a Hazmat spill which presented a hazard to the environment and a roadway congestion problem.

On April 28th Captain Clements attended the Emergency Managers meeting in Belmont.

On May 4th two Pacifica Police Sergeants attended a Neighborhood Watch meeting at the Moose lodge; about 50-60 residents from the Fairway neighborhood were in attendance.

On May 9th a community member notified the police department via NextDoor that they have contacted the Department of Fish and Wildlife in hopes to hold a meeting in the future to address coyotes. Details of this meeting are in progress.

On May 11th the first Earthquake Preparedness course was presented by Brek Hitz CERT California and held at the Pacifica Police Department. Over 25 attendees participated in this 90 minute course. The feedback of this course was positive.

Captain Clements registered the department for the upcoming San Mateo County Disaster Preparedness day on June 11 at the San Mateo County Event Center.
