### COMMISSION COMMENTS:

Commissioner Blackburn said the exercise Cascadia Rising (additional info at Fema.gov) was held in Oregon and Washington and FEMA did not participate. FEMA did not attend however regions 9 and 10 has participated in the past. Commissioner Blackburn mentioned various areas of the state will be fighting for resources and the fire season is in full swing.

The Department of Fish and Wildlife was contacted and a meeting will be held to address recent sightings of coyotes.

Last month the CERT medical branch obtained two new backboards.
