Minutes of March 23, 2011

In attendance were members Paul Jones, Joe Murphy, Mike Pacelli, Jim Sullivan, Noel Blincoe, Chuck Evans, Dan Briesach, staff liaison Lee Diaz; and guest Ron Maykel. Member Sam Casillas was absent.

Item 1. Call to Order

Co-Chair Paul Jones called the meeting to order at 6:37 PM.

Item 2. Approval of Order of Agenda

It was moved by Chuck Evans and seconded by Mike Pacelli to approve the order of agenda. The motion passed 7-0.

Item 3. Approval of Minutes of March 2, 2011

It was moved by Mike Pacelli and seconded by Jim Sullivan to approve the minutes of March 2, 2011, as submitted. The motion passed 6-0 (Dan Briesach abstained).

Item 4. Oral Communications

Ron Maykel mentioned that there is a pile of trash at the entrance to the Waste Water Treatment Plant and debris on the trail to Mori Point. Ron also said that he was concerned about off-leashed dogs at the Quarry property.

Item 6. Review of DEIS for Pet Management, provide comments and recommendations and plan for coordinated review

Paul Jones stated that the public review period for the DEIS has been extended to May 30th.

The committee continued the discussion and review of the sites listed on the DEIS.

The committee felt that the DEIS does not provide enough information on Mori Point. Paul Jones felt that Mori Point should be an all leash dog area. Noel stated that dogs should not be allowed on Mori Point.

It was moved by Mike Pacelli and seconded by Paul Jones to support an on-leash dog trail beyond what is being shown on the map. The motion passed 5-2 (Noel Blincoe opposed and Dan Briesach abstained).

Mike Pacelli stated that the north western part of the trail should be an enforcement area for dogs. Paul Jones said that people and dogs should be kept off the northern area because of sensitive plant species that exist in that area.

Paul Jones stated that Map C relating to Pedro Point does not show the existing trails constructed by the Land Trust. Mike Pacelli stated that those trails should be delineated on the map to provide better comments.

Paul Jones and Joe Murphy agreed to put all the comments into a format and then send a draft to all committee members for review at the next meeting.

Item 7. Announcements

Jim Sullivan mentioned that he can lead walks on Mori Point during the weekdays.

Chuck Evans said he talked to the City Manager about the status of the GGNRA Liaison Committee. Chuck also mentioned that he attended the informational meeting on the DEIS at Cabrillo School.

Noel announced that the 2011 Open Space Preservation Award recipient is Mike Vasey.

Paul Jones asked about the status of the openings on the GGNRA Liaison Committee.
