APPROVAL

OF MINUTES: The minutes for the May 15, 2013 meeting were approved with one correction. Commissioner Blackburn participated in Golden Guardian at the Federal level not the State.

OF AGENDA: Agenda for the June 19, 2013 was approved.

COMMISSION COMMENTS:

The Commission discussed the date to re-apply for the position on this commission as a result of new City of Pacifica resolutions effecting membership on all City of Pacifica commissions and committees.

Appointments for positions on the Emergency Preparedness and Safety Commission will occur in September 2013 and November in subsequent years.

EX-OFFICIO COMMENTS:

Ex-Officio Member Wisell reported that the Pacifica School District has ordered and will be installing lock boxes at each school. This will allow police and fire to have access to keys to the school in the event of an emergency.

Olga Crowe reported that Red Cross deployed to a large fire in Pescadero that effected several families. She informed the commission that Red Cross does not concern itself with the immigration status of people who are in need of assistance during an emergency.

STAFF COMMENTS:

Sergeant Londerville participated in the San Mateo County Disaster Preparedness Day at the San Mateo County Fair on June 8, 2013. There were two CERT members from the City of Pacifica participated in the CERT demonstrations and training exercise. This was a new idea to put on various exhibitions of CERT response to disaster related incidents and to conduct training of CERT members at the same time. The overall concept went well and it may be expanded on next year.

Captain Spanheimer and Sergeant Londerville are working on attending a train the trainer course for the CERT program in order to facilitate CERT training courses at the Pacifica Police Department.

Sergeant Londerville will contact Ex-Officio Member Schultz about applicants for the intern position.

Captain Spanheimer reported that the County of San Mateo is revising the active shooter protocol. The plan is to complete the revisions by the beginning of this school year. Law Enforcement, School districts and fire are part of the committee working on this undertaking.

Captain Spanheimer is completing the final aspects for Pacifica to be certified as tsunami ready. Once all the requirements for tsunami ready are completed the city will also be storm ready.
