

Yesterday evening (August 26, 2015) Caltrans identified that there was a problem with the vehicle signal detection wiring at the Fassler Ave. intersection and advised us that they have corrected the problem.

Here is a statement from Caltrans “This issue was related to emergency hardware repair. Our field electricians office for signals maintenance reports an electrician took the priority call last night. When he was at the location he identified that there was a problem with the vehicle signal detection wiring, and he fixed the problem so that the intersection is back to normal operation. “

Pacifica Police officers will be monitoring traffic at the intersection during the evening commute and will intervene if the problem occurs again. As an added measure, Caltrans will be meeting with Pacifica’s Public Works Department in September and October, to discuss the corridor including maintenance, signals and upcoming projects so we are fully aware of any Caltrans activities.
