San Pedro Creek Bridge Construction Update (State Route 1) Pacifica

San Mateo County- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin final paving operations on U.S. State Route 1 (northbound/southbound) between Post Mile 40.6 (Ace Hardware) to Linda Mar Boulevard in Pacifica, starting Tuesday, September 8, and completed by Thursday, September 10, from 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

San Pedro Avenue will have one-way traffic control with flaggers: September 8, 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM

Linda Mar Boulevard & State Route 1 will have various lane closures: September 9, 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM

State Route 1 will have alternating lane closures in both directions, and limited one-way traffic control: September 10, 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM

Note: This work will include grinding and paving operations at the intersection of Linda Mar Boulevard and State Route 1.

The paving work will affect signal timing for the entire week. Electrical work that controls the Route 1 and Linda Mar intersection will be worked on during the week of September 14, original signal timing will be restored by mid-week of September 14.

North and southbound temporary striping will be removed and replaced with permanent striping the week of, Monday September 21 and completed by Thursday, September 24, between the hours of 7:00 PM to 6:00 AM.





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Final paving will restore lanes both north and south of the bridge back to the original configurations. The area between the bridge and Linda Mar Boulevard will have two lanes starting closer to the bridge.

Changeable Message Signs have been posted in advance of the construction zone.

Final construction for this project will be completed by October, 2015.

This work is part of the San Pedro Creek Bridge Replacement Project that started construction in May 2014. The project will install a longer and higher bridge over the creek to provide capacity for the 100-year flood event. In addition, a Class 1 multi-purpose path will be added along its eastern side.

NOTE: Residents may notice increased noise from grinding/paving equipment and mandatory backup alarms while the contractor is working in the construction zone.
