APPROVAL

OF MINUTES: The minutes for the December 16, 2016 were approved.

APPROVAL

OF AGENDA: Agenda for the January 20, 2015 was approved.

COMMISSION COMMENTS:

Commissioner Blackburn reported a large increase of homeowners throughout the state of California have purchased flood insurance. Commissioner Blackburn said between the months of August to November (2015) the state has seen 28,000 new policies, and he was interested in the number for citizens of Pacifica who has purchased flood insurance.

Commissioner Erbacher reported he spent several hours in the RACES room with the Sheriff's Office testing the area simplex at 2meters and 6 meters. Erbacher also said he is working to get the CERT members in Pacifica radios.

Commissioner Shaw reported the City of Pacifica is beginning another Basic CERT class tomorrow and they currently have 25 persons enrolled.

Commissioner Salisbury reported the sale of Seton Hospital to Verity Health Care is complete. Salisbury said the hospital is preparing for Super Bowl as well, and added a "HIC" class (Hospital Incident Command) will be taking place on January 25, 2016 from 0830hrs to 1230hrs in building 1850, space is still available if interested. Salisbury said the hospital is also hosting a two day Hazmat certification course in the middle of March (details will follow).

EX-OFFICIO COMMENTS:

Steve Mahaley (OES)- reported the county is busy preparing for Super Bowl which will be held on Sunday February 7 2015, in Santa Clara. He also reported OES is actively monitoring the seawall in Pacifica.

Betty Fleming (Red Cross)-reported that Red Cross is looking for local faith base organizations to assist with shelter during the Super Bowl. They are currently working with the San Mateo County School districts to locate "alternatives" for housing during this time period.

STAFF COMMENTS:

Captain Clements reported he and Captain Spanheimer attended the City wide "El Nino" meeting on December 18 2015. They also attended the two day EOC Management Operations Training in Belmont.

Captain Clements reported (8) new CERT members were trained on web-EOC, which is an on-line emergency management system throughout San Mateo County.

Captain Clements reported he will be attending the Emergency Services Council Meeting tomorrow night in Redwood City. He added the city staff is working together to manage and mitigate the cliff sides, erosion of the shoreline, and the closure of Beach Blvd.

Captain Spanheimer said he is meeting with all the schools on February 10, 2016 and presenting to school staff on active shooter to include the San Mateo County protocol.

Captain Spanheimer said one CERT member attended a shelter operations class at Skyline College and the City of Pacifica currently has 1 person in background to become one of the police department's emergency managers.

Jeff Leong spoke of his experience working with NERT (Neighborhood Emergency Response Team) in San Francisco and volunteered his services to the commission.
