GGNRA's comment period is open until May 25, 2016. GGNRA will hold a public meeting regarding the Proposed Rule for Dog Management on March 31, 2016, 6:00 – 8:00 pm at the Community Center, 540 Crespi Drive. The OSPAC will discuss the proposed rule as it relates to GGNRA areas within the City of Pacifica. The City itself does not have jurisdiction over the proposed rules. Therefore, the City is considered a "commenting agency" with no approval authority.
