COMMISSION COMMENTS:

Commissioner Balestreri reported that he attended a the three-day California Hospital Association disaster planning conference. The main focus this year was planning for response to an active shooter incident and response specifically to pediatrics.

Commissioner Shaw attended a training symposium at Stanford. The topics included psychological effects on 1st responders due to stress and fatigue. A military representative involved in trauma centers spoke about triage centers and effects from the war on terrorism. Commissioner Shaw also discussed was the probable medical improvements

that will occur as a result of the war on terrorism similar to what advancements that were made following the Vietnam War.

Commissioner Chiechi stated that the Hilltop Mall in Richmond California will be having an emergency drill involving the public for the first time as part of their disaster planning. The exercise will be an active shooter and include the tenants and evacuation drill of customers.
