### Sanchez Dog Park Rules

1. Park users and dog owners assume all risk related to dog park use.
2. Dogs must be leashed when entering and exiting the dog park.
3. Please be respectful and courteous of all park neighbors and tenants. Quiet your dogs if barking excessively and refrain from loud conversation.
4. Children under the age of 12 are not permitted unless accompanied by an adult.
5. Please pick up your dog's waste and dispose of it in the proper receptacle.
6. Aggressive dogs are not permitted on the premises. Dogs must be removed at the first sign of aggression.
7. Female dogs in heat are prohibited from entering the park.
8. Dog owners must be in the park and attentive to their dogs at all times.
9. Fill any holes your dog digs.
10. All dogs must be currently licensed and vaccinated. Puppies under the age of 4 months are not allowed in the park.
11. Limit of three (3) dogs per person.
12. Failure to abide by the park rules may result in loss of privileges or owners may be ticketed.
13. Dog park is a smoke, drug and alcohol-free facility.
14. Dog owners are solely liable for injuries or damage caused by their dogs. This includes injury to another dog or person.



# Sanchez Dog Park

## Welcome to Our Community Dog Park

- a place where dogs and their owners can play!

Here's how to make the most of your experience:

### Expectations of Humans

- Keep your eyes constantly on your dog.
- Immediately remove waste to avoid dogs and humans stepping in it.
- Fill in holes to avoid twisted ankles on humans and dogs.
- Large dogs are not allowed in small dog area when small dogs are present.
- Keeping your dog from barking will help us be good neighbors.
- Respect the neighbors. We are lucky to have a neighborhood park, but it means we have nearby neighbors to respect.
- Talking on the phone is overheard by everyone, particularly neighbors sitting quietly in their home or yard. It's a good time to watch your dogs and not talk.

### Dog Play

- If dogs play with full contact, they need a break every 45 seconds, so the play does not escalate to a fight.
- Dog chasing needs to be balanced with dogs taking turns chasing each other.

- If a dog starts barking:
  1. Gently redirect them
  2. Give them some attention
  3. Throw a ball
  4. Do a pretend chase
- Keep your dog from rushing the entrance gate when a new dog enters.

### Sanchez Dog Park 1220 Linda Mar Blvd.

**From Hwy. 1, turn inland (east) on Linda Mar Blvd. and go about 1 mile. Dog park is behind the Pacifica Center for the Arts.**



- Keeping your dogs on leash to and from the park ensures they do not wander into nearby artists' rooms and other offices at the Sanchez Art Center.
- The adjacent fields are used by children for sports, keeping dogs in the dog park ensures these sport fields stay clean of dog waste.
- Children should never come into the dog park without an adult.
- Children should refrain from yelling and running in the dog park because that can trigger unacceptable behavior from the dogs.
- Human food should not come into the dog park.
