SEEKING APPLICANTS for the Sea Level Rise Community Work Group

The City of Pacifica is soliciting for applicants to participate in a Community Work Group (CWG) for the sea level rise vulnerability and adaptation planning updates to the City's Draft Local Coastal Plan (LCP). It is the City's objective to create a CWG with a balanced and inclusive representation of stakeholder interests in Pacifica, including: business, environment/conservation, real estate, recreation (including golf, beach use, surfing), and resident/neighborhood. The CWG will be a cornerstone of the LCP's stakeholder engagement program and it will help promote the exchange of information between members and foster understanding across stakeholder interests. The anticipated focus and schedule of the CWG meetings are as follows:

- Meeting #1: Vulnerability and Risk Assessment (January 2018)
- Meeting #2: Adaptation Plan (May 2018)
- Meeting #3: LCP Framework and Policy Language (August 2018)

The City will identify 15 to 25 members to participate in the CWG. All interested stakeholders are encouraged to apply. The public will be allowed to attend the CWG meeting, but public input during the CWG meetings would be limited as what the agenda allows.

Criteria for Selection

Sea Level Rise CWG members are expected to have the following attributes:

- 1. Able to attend each of the three CWG meetings, or identify an alternate to participate in their place for that meeting.
- 2. Able to provide local knowledge and expertise to inform the development of the LCP Update.
- 3. Willing to express fundamental interests (as opposed to fixed positions) and clearly convey the interests of one or more stakeholder groups.
- 4. Capable of working collaboratively, seeking to integrate the interests of the full range of stakeholder constituencies to formulate solutions.
- 5. Able to serve as "key communicators," including sharing project information and updates with other members of their respective organizations and the broader Pacifica community.

Preference will be given to residents of Pacifica and Pacifica business owners.

Additional Opportunities to Participate in the LCP Update Process

In addition to convening the Community Work Group, the City of Pacifica will also be holding three public workshops (dates TBD), convening a Technical Work Group (comprised of natural resource and regulatory agency staff), and providing Project updates on the Project website: www.cityofpacifica.org/SeaLevelRise. The public will be able to attend all meetings.
