

## RESOLUTION NO. 10-2019

### RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

**WHEREAS**, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, will receive an estimated \$600,000 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2019-20 from SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, this is the third year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

**WHEREAS**, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the communities priorities for transportation investment; and

**WHEREAS**, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate Monterey Road and add active transportation infrastructure in the City this year many other similar projects into the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in an "poor" condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "at risk" condition; and

**WHEREAS**, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets

infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND** by the City Council of the City of Pacifica, State of California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The following list of proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with fiscal year 2019-20 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Project: FY 2019-20 Pavement Rehabilitation Project

Description: The FY 2019-20 Pavement Rehabilitation Project will rehabilitate the pavement along Monterey Road from Oceana Boulevard to Hickey Boulevard to by placing 2 inches of asphalt overlay. This project will also include pavement grinding for base repair as well as installation of thermoplastic traffic striping, markings, and pavement markers.

Location: Monterey Road from Oceana Boulevard to Hickey Boulevard

Anticipated Year of Construction: 2019-2020

Estimated Useful Life: 20

3. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may utilize fiscal year 2019-20 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of Pacifica is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund this project with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

Project: Palmetto Sidewalk Project

Description: The project consists of the construction of 1,400 feet of sidewalk, curb and gutter along the west side of Palmetto Avenue.

Location: Palmetto Avenue from Westline Drive to 100 Palmetto Avenue

Anticipated Year of Construction: 2019-2020

Estimated Useful Life: 30


