Cabrillo School Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project

Starting April 13, 2020, the City's contractor, Mercoza, will begin the Cabrillo School Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project. Barring any weather-related delays, work is expected to be completed by June 2020.

The Cabrillo School Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project will install vegetated curb extension at the midblock crossing directly in front of the school. During wet weather events, the vegetated curb extensions will collect stormwater temporarily and filter it before entering the City's storm drain system or creeks. The vegetated curb extensions will help reduce or eliminate polluted stormwater runoff, reduce stormwater management costs, and increase pedestrian safety and aesthetic value of the street and neighborhood.

Project activities will be confined to the existing City ROW. The project does not involve grading or utility work. The project will remove existing asphalt pavement within the ROW and replace with new vegetated curb extension/bulb-outs.

The City has deemed this as an essential construction project as defined by the San Mateo County Shelter In Place Order as it is a public works infrastructure transportation safety project.

The City appreciates everyone's patience and cooperation for any inconveniences caused by construction activities as we strive to improve the City's pedestrian and storm drain facilities.
