Suspects Arrested in Stolen Vehicle

Pacifica, CA – On October 2, 2020 at approximately 7:20 am, Officers from the Pacifica Police Department responded to the 500 block of Esplanade Avenue on the report of a vehicle that had been driving recklessly in the area and was currently parked on the dirt shoulder with two persons in or about the vehicle.

Officers arrived on scene minutes later and contacted two subjects; one standing outside the open driver door and the other asleep in the front passenger seat. Upon contact, both displayed obvious signs and symptoms of being under the influence of a controlled substance. The vehicle was not registered to either subject and a request was made of the San Francisco Police Department to contact the vehicle's registered owner. The vehicle was subsequently found to have been stolen overnight from the rightful owner's garage.

Upon further inspection, the vehicle was found to be full of property that was stolen during a separate overnight burglary of a fitness center in San Francisco. A variety of suspected controlled substances, drug paraphernalia, and burglary tools were also found inside the vehicle and on both subject's persons.

The suspects have been identified as David Archer, a 30 year old resident of Walnut Creek, CA and Brian Rudy, a 34 year old resident of San Francisco. Both subjects were placed under arrest and booked at the San Mateo County Jail for 496D(A) PC – possession of a stolen vehicle, 11377(A) HS – possession of controlled substance, 11350(a) HS – possession of controlled substance, 496(a) PC – possession of stolen property, 466 PC – possession of burglary tools, 485 PC – misappropriation of property, 11550 HS – under the influence of a controlled substance, 11364(a) HS – possession of drug paraphernalia.
