# Notification of Pavement Work

July 2, 2021

## FY 2020-21 & FY 2021-22 PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT

**PACIFICA, CA** - The FY 2020-21 & FY 2021-22 Pavement Resurfacing Project will resurface approximately 11 miles (64 street sections) of City pavement and follows the Council approved 5-year Street Maintenance Program. Impacted residents have been notified and will be notified again two weeks and then 3 days prior to the start of work. The area for this project and the City's 5-year Street Maintenance Plan can be viewed at the below link and is generally within the northwest Linda Mar area with several streets in Park Pacifica:

The overall project scope will include roadway cape seals, double slurry seals, slurry seals, asphalt concrete and microsurfacing base repair, pavement striping and markings and other miscellaneous related work. The majority of the work relates to slurry seals which is an asphalt mix application applied over the existing street pavement. The slurry seal is comprised of a latex emulsified asphalt that will take 4-6 hours to cure on the street. Slurry seal allows the pavement to be sealed from water intrusion, which can cause deterioration of the street. When it cures it provides better traction and a wearing surface for traffic. Approximately 1 to 2 weeks after the slurry seal has been applied, permanent traffic striping will be installed, which will include the installation of bicycle route markers on some streets. This coating will allow the asphalt pavement to last longer but may not address existing issues related to roadway smoothness.

The project is slated to begin on **July 12, 2021 and will continue through October 2021, weather permitting**. Loud construction noises should be expected along with heavy-duty equipment. There will be periods in the daytime when traffic will be rerouted to avoid conflicts with construction, so vehicular movements through the area will be slower than what is normally experienced. Parking will also be restricted within the project's limits of work on Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and driveway access directly in front of the work will be blocked while the coating is hardening. Residents and motorists are advised to plan accordingly.
