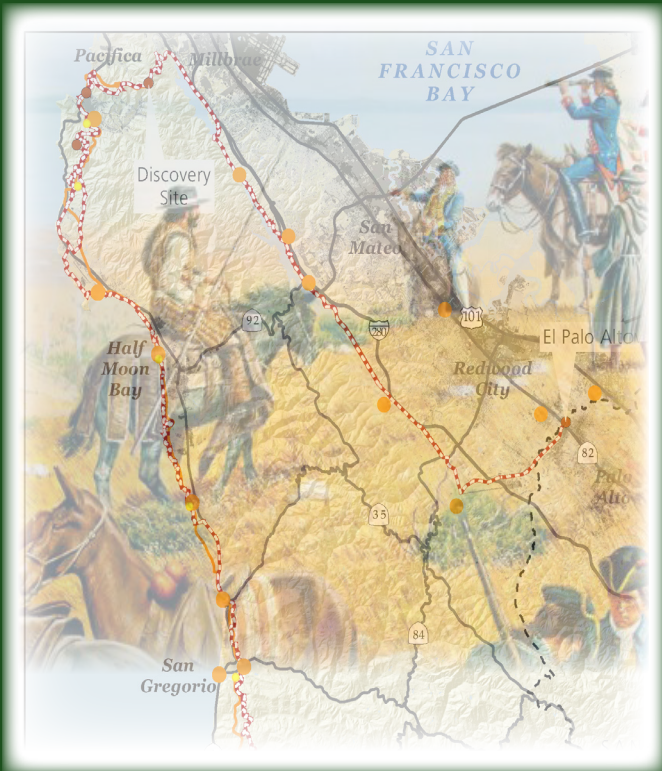


# COME JOIN US AS WE EXPLORE THE PATH OF PORTOLÁ 1769-2019 (250th Anniversary)



In 1769 a Spanish expedition in search of Monterey Bay led to the accidental sighting of the San Francisco Bay from atop Sweeney Ridge in Pacifica. This sighting was the catalyst for the future development of California

To mark the 250th anniversary of this event, the City of Pacifica and County of San Mateo are planning a series of events to be held throughout the year to tell the story of the expedition and of the Ramaytush Ohlone people who greeted the Spanish warmly.
