NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that due to the COVID-19 emergency and State and County Orders relating to COVID-19, the City Council of the City of Pacifica will conduct a public hearing on Monday, August 24, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. as a teleconference meeting only (no physical meeting location). Anyone interested in observing the meeting or providing public comments should refer to the meeting agenda for further details. The City of Pacifica will publish the meeting agenda not less than 72 hours prior to the meeting. The agenda will be available online at <https://pacificacityca.iqm2.com> and will also be posted in the City Hall window at 170 Santa Maria Avenue in Pacifica.

This meeting of the City Council is an Essential Governmental Function and is necessary to consider the following essential items of business:

CONSIDERATION OF AN AMENDMENT TO BEEKEEPING REGULATIONS, initiated by the City of Pacifica, to amend the City's Property Maintenance and Nuisance Abatement Regulations (Title 5, Chapter 25 of the Pacifica Municipal Code [PMC]) to include the maintenance of apiaries for beekeeping, to amend the City's Animal Control Regulations (Title 6, Chapter 1 of the PMC), and to rescind Section 4 of City Administrative Policy No. 35 in order to establish nuisance conditions and remove all permitting requirements and standards for beekeeping within the City of Pacifica. The amended regulations would be applicable citywide. Recommended California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) status: Exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3).
