

**RESOLUTION OF THE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND SAFETY
COMMISSION UPHOLDING JULY 31, 2025 DECISION OF VEHICLE HEARING
OFFICER DETERMINING THAT POTENTIAL VIOLATION OF PMC SECTION 5-
2.03 SHOULD BE RESCINDED AND DENYING THE APPEAL**

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2025, Vehicle Hearing Officer, Sergeant Aranda considered an appeal from a notice of potential violation of the City’s 72-hour parking prohibition (“warning notice”) issued to a vehicle (2002 Odyssey) registered to Julia Rapoza (“Appellant”) on July 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2025, the City Clerk received a timely appeal of the Vehicle Hearing Officer’s July 31, 2025 decision from the Appellant; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2025, the City Clerk issued a notice of the hearing to be held on September 17, 2025; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2025 the Emergency Preparedness and Safety Commission convened and conducted an appeal hearing pursuant to Pacifica Municipal Code section 5-2.07 and considered all pertinent facts and testimony presented.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Emergency Preparedness and Safety Commission as follows:

- A. The above recitals are true and correct and material to this Resolution.
- B. In making its findings, the Emergency Preparedness and Safety Commission relied upon and hereby incorporates by reference all correspondence, the staff report, and other related materials.
- C. The appeal filed by the Appellant is denied. The Emergency Preparedness and Safety Commission finds that the hearing conducted on July 31, 2025 to consider the (“warning notice”) issued to a vehicle (2002 Odyssey) registered to Julia Rapoza (“Appellant”) on July 27, 2025, was conducted in accordance with Pacifica Municipal Code section 5-2.06 and the Appellant was given notice, afforded the opportunity to speak and present evidence at that hearing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the that the decision of the Vehicle Hearing Officer dated July 31, 2025 determining that potential violation of Pacifica Municipal Code section 5-2.03 should be rescinded and that no violation of PMC section 5-2.03 occurred, is upheld.
